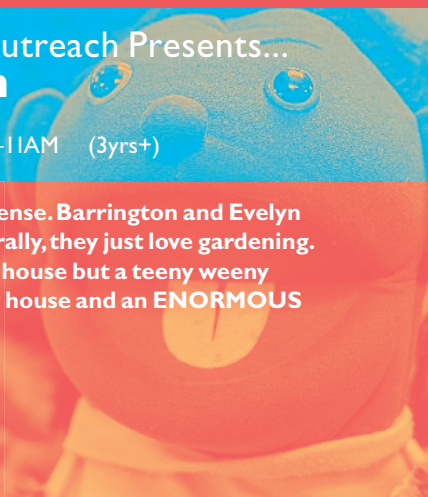

Mac and Bob's Party Problem

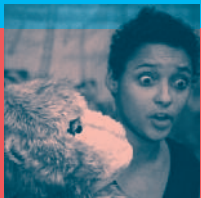
