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Educational Visits Coordinator and Headteacher Training

All new EVCs must attend an initial day's training course. Existing Headteachers and EVC's are also welcome to attend if they would like to refresh and update their knowledge.

It is also important for all new Headteachers to be fully aware of LA policies and procedures, and to understand their responsibilities regarding Educational Visits so they should arrange to attend an induction course.

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Outdoor Teambuilding and Problem Solving

Visit Planning and the Use of ROVER Online

Duke of Edinburgh Award - "In-House" Training and Refresher Course for Expedition Supervisors

This 2-day course is provided for those staff who help to train and supervise Duke of Edinburgh Award expedition groups. The course aims to share ideas and good practice, and to refresh and improve knowledge and skills. Participants should gain competence and confidence in navigation and group management skills, and a "statement of competence" can be provided, if appropriate. Experienced supervisors need to attend day 2 only – contact the LA Duke of Edinburgh Award Coordinator for advice.

"Learning Outside the Classroom" "Come and Try It" day for Teaching Staff

This is an opportunity to explore the value and relevance of teaching and learning outside the classroom. Ski Visit Organiser

This is not the official Snowsport Course Organiser (SCO) Award, but the course has been designed for those staff wishing to organise and lead ski visits abroad, especially for the first time. The organisation and leadership of school ski visits is considerably more complex and demanding than many other school visits, and staff are recommended to undertake this training at an early stage of the planning process.
