

Dates and Deadlines for Statutory Tests

November:

Identify students who need access arrangements – make sure you have information from relevant specialists – e.g. doctor, educational psychologist

Obtain all the relevant information and evidence to support your application

Check details of how to apply for special consideration (available at naa.org.uk/tests)

Applications for early opening and additional time can be made from now on until 3rd March 2008

Deadline for ordering KS2 and KS3 materials

December:

Pupil registration opens for national curriculum tests

January:

February: Schools receive confirmation of modified test orders

Modified test administrators' guides are available to download from the NAA website

Reminder – deadline for making applications for early opening or additional time applications 3rd March

March: Schools receive Test Administrators' Guides and checklists from NAA
Schools register additional students taking tests (i.e. early or late takers and new arrivals)

Delivery of Optional Tests 3 – 14 March

Reminder – check the progress of applications for early opening or additional time by logging on to the 'Test Forms' section of the NAA website

April

Schools receive stationery materials and HDF

Schools receive details of information for script collection

Guidance on the submission of teacher assessments and P SCALE data available on the website

Reminder – check the progress of applications for early opening or additional time by logging on to the Test Forms section of the NAA website

May:

From Thurs 1st May

Teacher assessment and P SCALE collection site opens

6 – 9 May KS3 tests take place

12 – 16 May KS2 tests take place

All scripts collected from schools

Fri 16th May – KS3 deadline for submitting HDF

Tues 20th May – deadline for KS2/KS3 special consideration applications

Thurs 22nd – KS2 deadline for submitting HDF
