Biography of Anne Frank:

Anne Frank was a girl who is born in Germany. She was a Jewess. She was born on the 12th of June in 1929 in Frankfurt am Main. Four years later she has moved to the Netherlands with her parents and her sister. She has moved to Holland because Hitler was the ruler in 1933 in Germany. He has prosecuted the Jews. So, Anne Frank and her family aren't safe anymore in Germany. For seven years they were safe in Holland. On the 6th of July 1942 Anne Frank and her family goes underground in the 'Anne Frank-house'. For two years and one month they'll be safe in that secret building. On the 4th of August in 1944 the police is coming by Anne Frank to arrest her and all the people who has living in the 'Anne Frank-house'. First they were taken to concentration camp, Westerbork. Then to Bergen-Belsen. In this camp Anne and her sister, Margot, died in this camp on thirteenth.

Her Family:

The name of Anne's father was Otto Frank. He is born in Frankfurt am Main. The name of her mother was Edith Holländer. She is born in Aken. Otto and Edith were married on the 12th of May in 1925 in Aken. Their honeymoon were in San Marino, in Italy. She has also a older sister. Her name is Margot. She is born on the 16th of February in 1926. The name of Anne's grandmother is Alice Frank-Stern. Her grandfather died in 1909.

Anne's diary:

Anne Frank kept a diary from 12 June 1942 till 1 August 1944.

She invents 'Kitty', a girlfriend, whom she can tell about her experiences, sorrow and anger.

The diary was a small present for her thirteenth birthday.

She begins her new diary with the following extremely significant sentence:

'June 12, 1942.

I hope I can confide everything to you, such as I haven't been able to confide in anyone, and I hope that you will be a great help to me.'

Two months later from here hiding place, she writes:

'September 28, 1942.

Oh, I'm so glad. I brought you along'

In the beginning Anne only writes for herself. Until the minister of education, in a radio broadcast from London, reports that after the war a collection of all the diaries and letters will be made.

Then Anne starts to rewrite her diary. She corrects parts and leaves other out.

On the 25th of June in 1947 her diary has come out.

Otto Frank in the Second World War:

Anne's grandmother moved to Switzerland, too go to her family. In the Autumn find Otto Frank a house in Amsterdam at it Merwedeplein. On the 10th of May in 1940 Germany attacked Holland.

Holland was occupied by Germany. The Jews were insulted in the newspapers, but they still can play outside.

On the 1st of December in 1940 moved Otto with his company to the Prinsengracht 263. The Jews can't have a own company. So, Otto must give his company to Victor Kugler and Johannes Kleiman. The Jews did may nothing.
